### **Content Requirements for Art Certification:**

Candidates are required to possess a Bachelor's degree and successful completion of the following:

- 30 semester hours or more of art content course work at an Institute of Higher Education
- 12 upper division semester hours or more of art content course work at an Institute of Higher Education
- A minimum of 50 percent of content course work must be taken at the same institution
- A GPA of at least 3.0
- Adolescent or Developmental Psychology

A composite score of at least a 527 on the PRAXIS I or a score of at least 1100 on the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is required for admission. Students may be admitted provisionally without passing PRAXIS I or GRE scores but are required to achieve a qualifying score by the end of the first semester of study in the program.
