UMBC requires that all students seeking teacher certification in German, French, or Spanish achieve a minimum rating of "Advanced Low" on the Oral Proficiency Interview and the Writing Proficiency Test administered by Language Testing International.

All MAT applicants must meet with an advisor from our Modern Language and Linguistics Department to have an informal assessment of their language proficiency and receive recommendations for language coursework. MAT students should meet with their education advisor each semester.

The internship occurs in two phases that are consecutive. Students should complete the application for internship on TK20 during the spring semester prior to starting Phase I. In Phase I, fall only, students spend at least two half days per week at that assigned placement school. In Phase II, spring only, students start their full-time internship in early January, following the schedule of their assigned school.
