**Program Policies**

- EDUC 417, EDUC 416, EDUC 418, EDUC 419 must be taken in sequence.
- Students must earn an A or B in all Education courses.
- All students must open a Tk20 account.
- Qualifying scores on Praxis I (until 8/2017), Praxis CORE, SAT, or ACT are required for admission.
- Students must maintain a 2.75 GPA for program admission and continuous enrollment.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA to enter and remain in Phase I and Phase II of internship.
- Internship Phases I and II must be completed in consecutive semesters, Fall-Spring or Spring-Fall.
- All coursework must be completed prior to entering Phase II.
- **Failure to exhibit professional behavior in coursework and field placement may result in student's removal from the program. Readmission is not guaranteed.**
- An extra fee for Phase II of internship is collected with that semester's tuition.

\*Some courses meet **GEP** requirements. Students must see their major advisor for GEP advising and should regularly complete a degree audit on myUMBC. Elementary Education is a certification program. All students must select an academic major from the approved list.
