

UMBC Regional Cohort Masters of Arts in Education (MAE) Concentration in PreK-12 STEM Education Program

The University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC) is offering a 36-credit, 12-course non-thesis Masters of Arts in Education Degree with a focus on STEM education. This program is designed to provide experienced teachers content knowledge, pedagogical content knowledge and enhance leadership skills across STEM disciplines. Program completion will result in the Masters of Arts degree.

Applications accepted now through December 15, 2017

Program Schedule

The program will run from Spring 2018 through Fall 2021 (4-year program). Teachers will attend three courses per year.

Admission Requirements

- Undergraduate degree with a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Teaching certificate
- Three professional or academic references
- Statement of goals/purpose

Program Delivery

UMBC will offer all courses on UMBC satellite sites near the main campus. Courses will be hybrid with a combination of face-2-face and online class sessions.

Program Cost

Reduced Tuition: Cohort will pay a reduced tuition rate of \$1,050.00 per course (\$350.00 per credit).
